

Passover and Jesus the Lamb of God

The Fulfillment of the First Step



Background – Leviticus 23

- And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- ² Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts.
- ⁴ These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.
- ⁵ In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the LORD's Passover.

The Process – The Exodus 12 Example

- And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt saying,
- ² This month shall be unto you **the beginning** of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.
- ³ Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house:
- ⁴ And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the lamb.

This Process is How You Get Saved - Watch

⁵ Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats:

⁶ And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it **in the evening**.

⁷ And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

Salvation and Freedom Involves a Process

- Same process that God gives to Israel is the same process for us.
- Jesus follows the same process to fulfill prophecy.
- He shows us how to follow the steps.
- If we do what God tells Israel to do, then we will get what Israel received....forgiveness and freedom.
- Keep this scripture in mind as we continue....John Chapter 1

**²⁹ The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said,
“Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”**

Key Points – Put Yourself in the Story

- The Word comes to them in Egypt – while in bondage and in need
 - It always starts there
- God changed the calendar and the time – It's Time
- Bring the Lamb into the house 4 days prior
- 4 days to check the lamb for blemishes – lamb gotta be straight
- Everybody participates in the process, no exceptions
- Killed the lamb at 3pm – between the evening....this is important
- Take the blood and apply it outside
- Eat or take in the lamb

Jesus is the Real Deal – The Lamb of God – John Chapter 12

12 Then Jesus six days before the Passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was, which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.

² There they made him a supper; and Martha served: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him.

12 On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,

13 Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.

What day does Jesus come into Jerusalem?

Examined 4 Days, Nothing Wrong With The Lamb

- Chief Priests found no fault – Matthew 21
- Pilate found no fault – Matthew 27
- Herod found no fault – Luke 23
- High Priest found no fault – John 18
- Judas found no fault – Matthew 27
- Centurian found no fault – Matthew 27
- Repentant thief found no fault – Luke 23

Proper Application – Come Correct

⁸ And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it.

⁹ Eat not of it raw, nor sodden at all with water, but roast with fire; his head with his legs, and with the purtenance thereof.

¹¹ And thus shall ye eat it; with your loins girded, your shoes on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and ye shall eat it in haste: it is the LORD's Passover.

¹² For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.

¹³ And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I **will pass over you**, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.

Do the Instructions Apply to Us? Yes!

What did Jesus mean by eating His flesh? John Chapter 8

⁵¹ I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world.”

⁵² The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, “How can this Man give us *His* flesh to eat?”

⁵³ Then Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. ⁵⁴ Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.

It Is the Word....Word Up!

John Chapter 1 -- In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

¹⁴ And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

³ So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every *word* that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.
Deuteronomy Chapter 8

Key Passover Application for Them & Us

- Put some fire on it
- Unleavened bread
- With bitter herbs
- Don't water it down
- Get ready to move quick
- Apply the blood where God can see it
- When He sees the blood, you escape judgement
- Take word of God with the fire
- Read without sin
- Don't celebrate your past B.C.
- Take the whole word, not parts
- Don't stay like this – time to move
- Can't be under cover saint
- When you accept Jesus – like this – you are forgiven – part of the plan

Why 3pm? Because Jesus Follows the Plan – Matthew Chapter 27

⁴⁶ And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

⁵⁰ Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.

⁵¹ And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

3pm is the 9th hour.

The same time lambs are slain is the same time Christ dies on the cross. Why?

The first step to going further and closer to God and His promises, starts at the cross

Jesus – the Hope Dealer – Psalm 22

My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?

² O my God, I cry in the day time, but thou hearest not; and in the night season, and am not silent.

⁶ But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people.

⁷ All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying,

⁸ He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.

¹¹ Be not far from me; for trouble is near; for there is none to help.

¹⁴ I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax;

¹⁵ My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws;

¹⁶ For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have inclosed me: **they pierced my hands and my feet.**

¹⁷ I may tell all my bones: they look and stare upon me.

¹⁸ They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.

¹⁹ But be not thou far from me, O LORD: O my strength, haste thee to help me.

²² I will declare thy name unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee.

²⁴ For he hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath he hid his face from him; but when he cried unto him, he heard.

²⁵ My praise shall be of thee in the great congregation: I will pay my vows before them that fear him.

It's All About The Plan & The Process

- Why did God give Israel Exodus...to reveal the plan for a new start
- Why did Jesus come in the house on the 10th? Following the plan
- Why die at 3pm? Fulfilling the plan
- Why Bible study and the thief....to show you the plan gives hope
- Why didn't they break any bones...not part of the plan
- Why is Joseph's tomb empty....to show us how He brings us out
- The process is the same, for Israel, for Jesus, for us....we get the same results...if we follow the plan
- God gave them Passover so they could understand the death of Christ for salvation

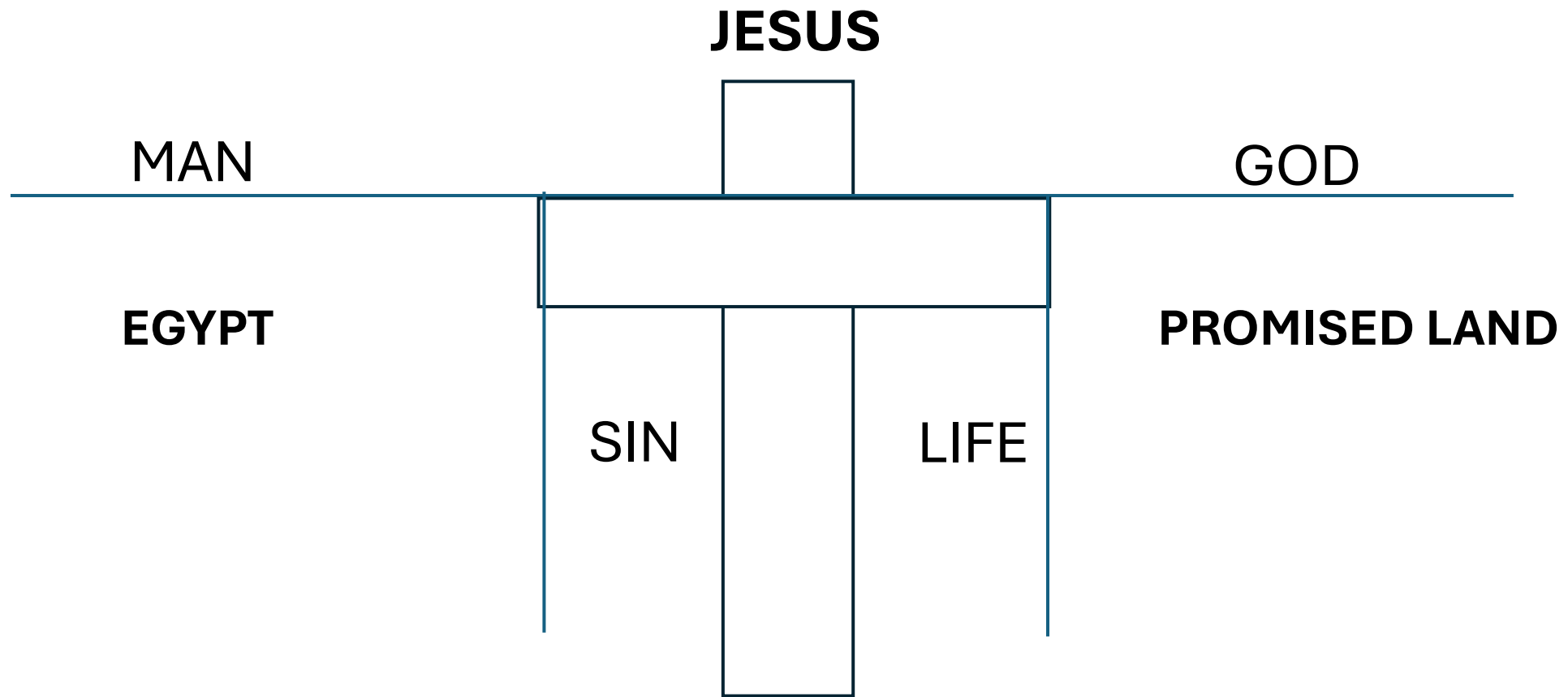
Do You Need God to Passover Your Sins?
